The Jamaica Foundation for Islamic Charity (JFIC) is a legally registered non-profit Charitable Organisation which was founded in 2013 with the expressed mandate of facilitating charitable and other forms of moral and spiritual support, primarily to Muslim communities in Jamaica.

JFIC partners with stakeholders including local Masjids, private sector organizations and international organizations to assist the needy with food and other essential items and pave a road to self-empowerment. The work of Jamaica Foundation for Islamic Charity is primarily funded by donations.

Our goal is to work towards a solution to the problem of poverty in Jamaica via improvements in an individual's standard of living.

# OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the organization are:

- To distribute food and food-related products to those requiring assistance.
- To accept donations of food, clothing and other items for redistribution.
- To accept donations of money or other property for redistribution.
- To collect, inspect, catalog and store items for redistribution.
- To provide assistance in housing and medical supplies/expenses.
- To coordinate the provision of training and mentorship as needed and within limits.

- To provide counselling and wellness services.
- To provide scholarships, grants and stipends.
- To provide assistance in the building of institutions.
- To cooperate with other organisations with similar objectives.
- To provide relief in the event of catastrophes to needy families or persons.

# FOOD BASKET PROGRAM

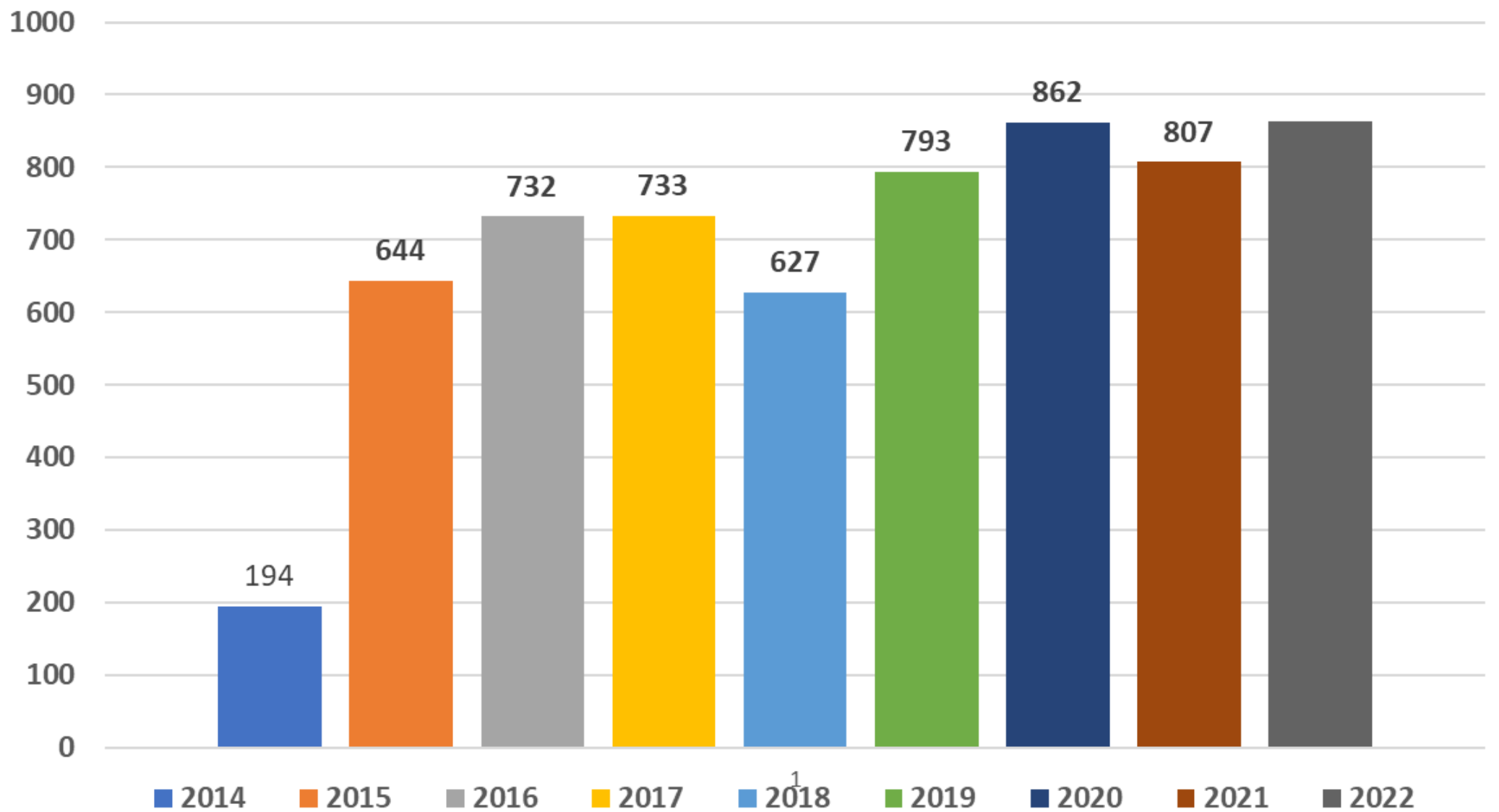
A total of 864 Food Baskets were issued in 2022. This represents a 6% increase from the previous year.

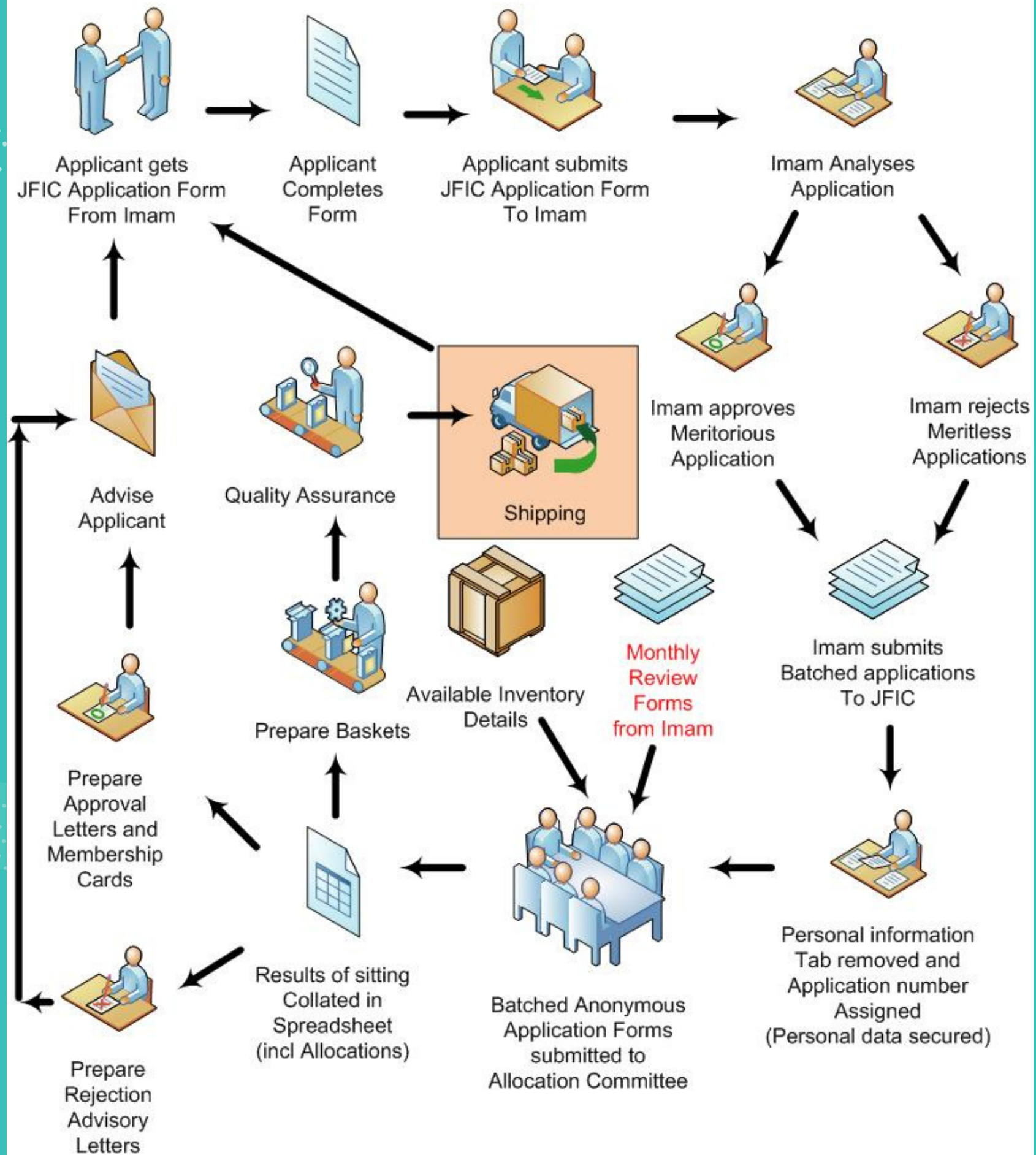
This does not include food items donated to random persons who reached out to, and were assisted by, the JFIC over the same period.

To date, we have been able to provide support to over 200 family units, issuing 6,256 food baskets since inception, targeting the needy

We have defined a food basket that is geared at providing periodic sustenance for families in 2 weeks tranches. Our application process includes a rigorous vetting process which seeks to categorize beneficiaries in one of two groups:

- Group 1 - Persons unable to work due to age/disability
- 
- Group 2 – Able-bodied persons unable to find gainful employment. For this group we will provide temporary assistance and mentoring geared at weaning them in the shortest possible time.

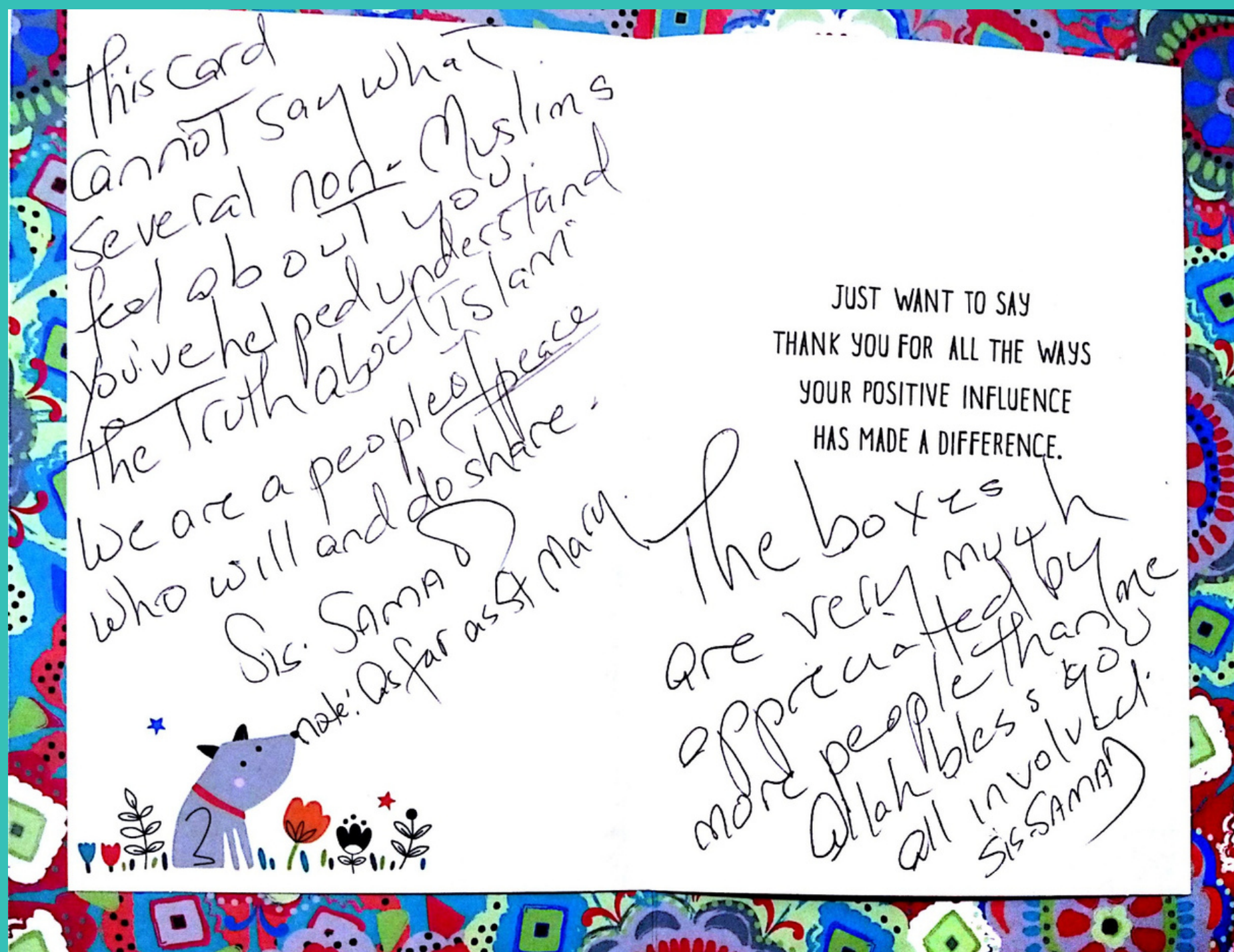
